

Invitation IRO MRT Area Preparation

Kranjska Gora (SI), 08.04. – 10.04.2022

Information

The participants get an introduction to the IRO MRT Area Guidelines as well as to the IRO MRT FL Score Sheet. They learn where the priorities are set at the IRO MRT FL and what thus needs to be kept in mind. One part is the correct handling of the GPS device, which is dealt with both theoretically and practically. An IRO Veterinarian explains the basics of First Aid for the dogs, which are then also practically trained.

During the search work, the teams should show their current level. At the end of every search, each team receives extensive feedback on its performance in order to support their preparation for the IRO MRT FL. At the end of the Module, there will be a general feedback round, summing up the most important points of every worksite/search work, which should constitute a further input for training. Additionally, the Classifiers will share their personal opinion with every team as to whether the team's current level of training is sufficient to participate in the IRO MRT FL.

Please note that the number of participants is limited. The participants will be ranked according to the date of receipt and will receive a confirmation after the registration deadline.

Prerequisites

- » Participants have to be able to communicate in English
- » Proof of a successful RH-FL A test according to IPO-R
- » <u>Vaccination confirmation by a veterinarian as proof of vaccinations</u> according to the <u>IRO Vaccination Scheme</u> (Leptospirosis, Parvovirosis, Distemper, Hepatitis and Rabies) for the dog
- » High level of physical fitness
- » Valid insurance and all necessary vaccinations to travel to and in Slovenia
- » Participants have to bring their own GPS devices

Accommodation

» For the duration of the Module, the participants have the possibility to stay at the following accommodation:

- » Accommodation is arranged in double or single rooms with breakfast. Lunch and dinner have to be organized by the participants themselves.
- Costs for an accomodation in shared double rooms:
 35 EUR per person / night (incl. breakfast).
- Costs for an accomodation in a single room:
 45 EUR per person / night (incl. breakfast).
- The accommodation can be booked either from the 07.4. 10.4. (3 nights) or from 08. 10.4.2022 (2 nights). Teams arriving before or departing after these dates have to arrange accommodation for these extra days on their own.
- » The accomodation has to be booked together with the application. The costs have to be paid together with the registration fee (see below).
- » Dogs are allowed in the rooms.

Costs

As soon as your participation has been confirmed by the IRO Office, the participation fee of € 125 + accommodation for IRO members (€ 225 + accommodation for non-IRO-members) is due.

- » Please be prepared that at the beginning of April, temperatures could be very low in the area (possibly snow or rain). Therefore, we strongly recommend ensuring to bring sufficiently warm equipment for both humans and dogs.
- >> Upon consultation with the IRO Office, participants are allowed to bring helpers/observers. They can only act as helpers/observers if they are duly registered and their participation is confirmed by the IRO Office.
 Helpers/observers may act as hiding persons and watch the practical parts of the training, however, they are not allowed in the theoretical and feedback lectures. The IRO reserves its right to limit the number of helpers/observers if needed.
